



Per Diem Emergency Shelter Attendant

Join Tedford Housing as a per diem Family & Adult Emergency Shelter Attendant for our emergency shelters in Brunswick.

The Shelter Attendant is an integral part of the shelter team. Attendants will monitor guest and house activities, ensure that guests are supported in working towards their goals and contribute to the safe operation of the program overall. Staff will conduct intakes, maintain basic client records, provide orientation to those entering the shelters, and serve as a point of contact for guests in accessing resources and in emergency situations.

Tedford Housing is looking for an organized and energetic team member demonstrating good judgement, a positive attitude, flexibility and a commitment to the mission of Tedford to empower people to move from homelessness to home.

The position is ideal for the person who is looking for two to three shifts per week and for those looking to begin or to expand their experience and skills in a human services setting.

This is an unbenefited, per diem position with the potential to transition to part-time for the right individual.

One year of experience is preferred with a minimum of a high school or GED education.

The adult and family shelters are open every day.

Schedule to be comprised of 2nd and/or 3rd shift evening, overnight and weekend shifts.

The hourly rate is \$17 an hour, with a shift differential of \$1.00/hour for all 3rd shift hours worked.
